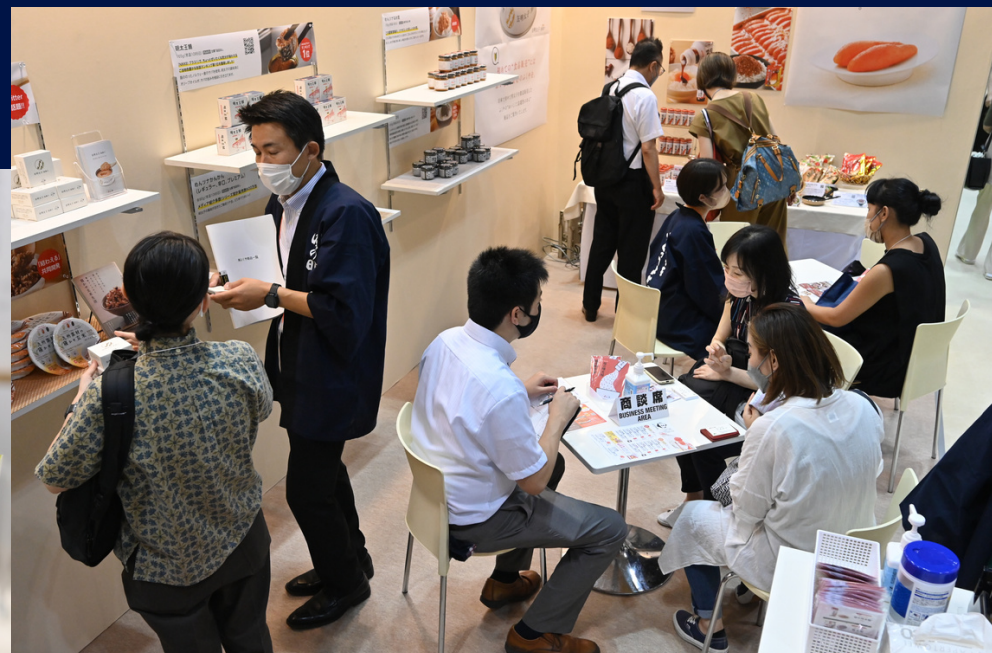
Thousands of high-quality/design products and a wide range of “Made-in-Japan” products were showcased at three days of the show.

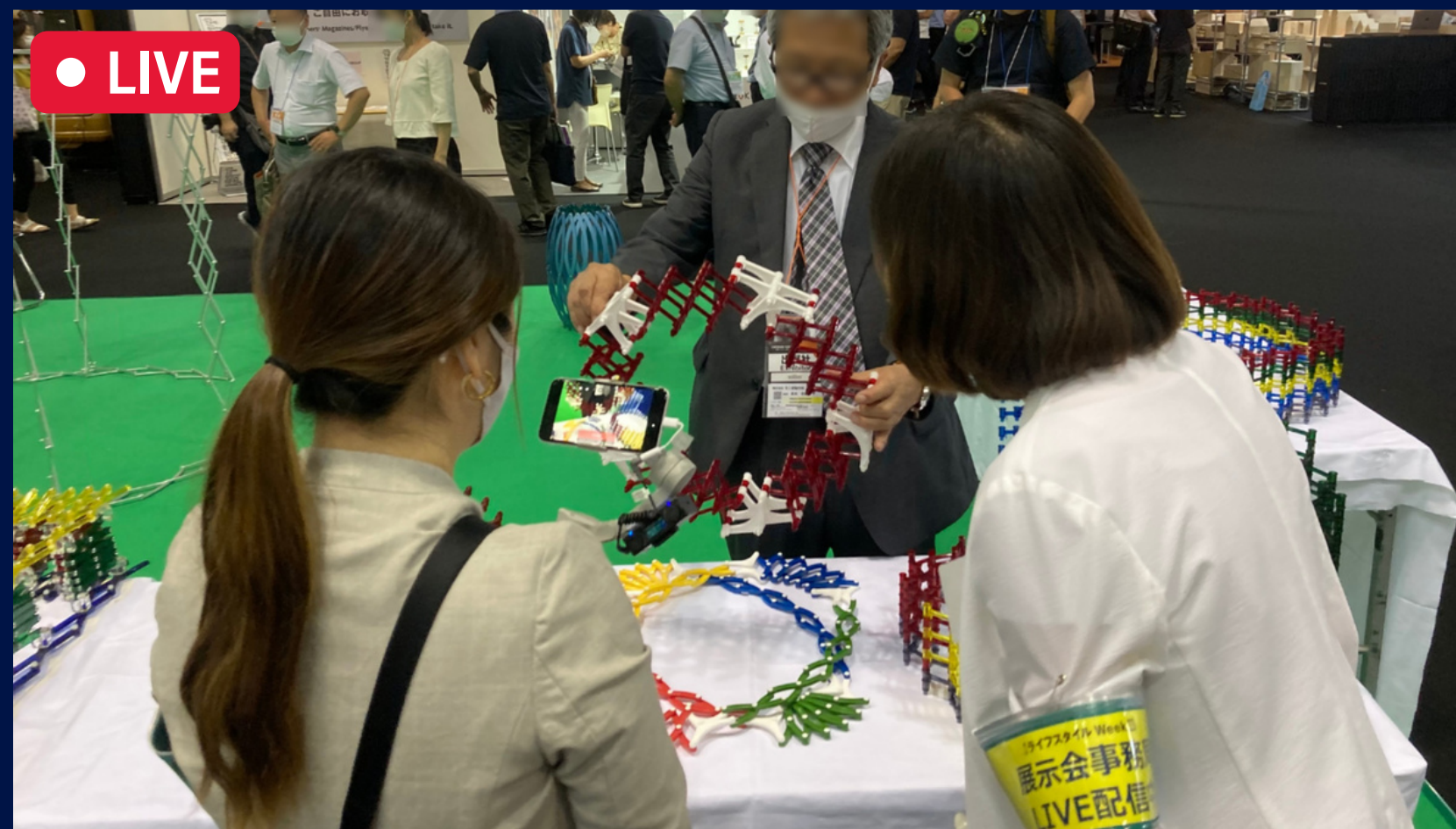
